We are presenting scene eight of a full-length play written in 2006. Lynn Redgrave starred in the title role at the premiere in New York's MCC Theater. It was co-authored by Mick Gordon, an award-winning director, and A. C. Grayling, a professor of philosophy and author of many books, including one entitled *Against All Gods*.

Torchy Hunter (Grace) first appeared on a stage in the 3rd grade, was a drama minor at Pomona College, and has worked in community theater in Colorado Springs, here with the Saratoga Drama group for which she played the Big Nurse in Cookoo's Nest, was in 10 Little Indians, and Barefoot in the park, and has worked professionally since 1987 with *Mystery by Design*.

With the exception of fourteen years he'd rather not remember, **Dan Zulevic** (Tom) has been on one stage or another almost every year since he was six years old. Aside from fronting rock bands, he's acted in "A Midsummer Night's Dream," "The Mouse That Roared," "Julius Caesar," "Big River," "Florodora," "The Music Man" and really, really wants to play Daddy Warbucks in "Annie." This will be the third time he's shared a stage with Torchy.

Dana Grover (Tony), a ten-plus year member of San Jose First Unitarian, has been recording audio books for Books Aloud for over twenty five years. He lasted acted while in college (a few or so years ago), and last "acted out" in high school. He is the father of two actors, and grandfather of a 3 1/2 year old granddaughter who recently performed in her first ballet recital.
