

Notes to the Leader for G061 – UU Principles 2 & 6

About this Session

This is the second in a suite of four sessions (G059, G016, G062, and G03) that calls for an in-depth examination of what we think about, and how we live out, our Unitarian Universalist principles. Our approach combines the principles into pairs and asks us to look not only at each one, but how they might conflict with and/or complement each other.
